So, some section talks and discussions will be arranged in English while others will have Russian as the working language.

Section talks and discussions where English is the working language will be arranged online. Students deliver 7-minute contributions, which are followed by questions from other participants. By the results of section talks and discussions, the best presentations will be chosen and awards granted.

After the conference organizational committee plan to publish papers in the post-conference volume, which will be indexed in RSCI (Russian Scientific Citation Index). Publications are free of charge. Participants who would like to have their contribution published should submit their papers until 25 December, 2020 (e-mail of organizational committee: arcticandnorth2020@gmail.com). Requirements for

publication are attached in Annex 2. Students should also submit recommendations of their academic advisers. The example of recommendation is attached in Annex 3.

Organizational committee and scientific consultants of the conference have the right to select papers for publication.

Requirements for the design of the paper for publication:

(If the requirements are not met, the texts will not be printed)

- Electronic version of the text in standard format MS Word (*.rtf; *doc);
- File names should be given by the author's name (Petrov.rtf; *doc).
- Volume – no more than seven pages: Times New Roman font; font size 12 points; line spacing – one and a half; margins: left – 3, right – 1.5 cm, bottom and top – 3 cm; red line in the text – 1.25 cm.
- The first line contains the full name of the author and supervisor (in italics, right-aligned); below the empty line – the title of the report in bold (center-aligned); on the next line – in italics – a brief abstract of the article (*up to 300 characters*), then – a list of keywords (*no more than 10*), below – the main text (width-aligned).
- Diagrams and drawings should be made in black and white, grouped and placed in the text of the report. Tables should have a title, figures should have captions. Place the table name above the table on the left, without paragraph indentation in one line with its number separated by a dash (table 1 – Name...). The word "drawing", its number and name should be placed in the middle of the line, separated by a dash (figure 1 – Name....).
- Links to an article/book/electrical source of information from the list of references should be printed in a line in square brackets [2, p. 32].
- List of references after the text.
